You need to contact us six weeks prior to departure otherwise it is unlikely that we will be able to offer you an appointment due to limited availability of clinics. Please complete the travel clinic form (from reception or our website) with your trip details and email address. You will be emailed with the advice and may contact reception to make an appointment if it is appropriate and provided by the NHS. You may need to go to an external travel clinic for your vaccines.

Malaria tablets are available on a private prescription, from online pharmacies or over the counter.



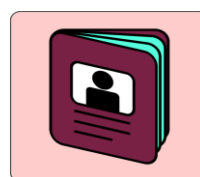

We also supervise foundation doctors spending a few months in general practice before returning to more hospital training.
